Things are heating up in the Massachusetts race for Governor in 2022, and Republicans seem to be heading towards a nasty primary fight. After Donald Trump endorsed a primary challenger to incumbent Republican Charlie Baker, the DGA commissioned a poll to gauge where the GOP primary stands today and gain perspective on the views of Republican base voters in Massachusetts, believing they may be different from other parts of the country.

What we found surprised us. Not only do Massachusetts Republican primary voters pledge their loyalty to Trump and adhere to toxic and extreme views, but their extremism has made Charlie Baker deeply unpopular and in serious trouble of losing the GOP nomination fight.

Baker is Massively Underwater with Republican Primary Voters

Despite being a two-term incumbent, Gov. Baker is in for a rude awakening. Among Republican Primary voters, Charlie Baker is badly underwater, with 54% of respondents having an unfavorable opinion of the Governor and only 30% having a favorable opinion.

Our poll confirms that Geoff Diehl is not only a serious threat but is probably the front-runner for the GOP nomination. He holds a commanding 21 point lead over Baker, including breaking the crucial 50% threshold. When Republicans learn of Trump's endorsement, Diehl's lead jumps to 32 points (25% Baker/ 57% Diehl). The sitting Republican governor cannot earn 40% of the vote among a single demographic group of Republican primary voters.

If the primary were held today, Governor Charlie Baker would lose 'bigly.'

Donald Trump Leads the Massachusetts GOP

For observers of Republican primary politics, it may be no surprise that Trump maintains a strong grip on the GOP. The former president is the key driver and motivator for Republican base voters and the measuring stick for judging candidates. Among GOP primary voters, 81% are favorable to the former president, with only 13% unfavorable.

Donald Trump's popularity is not limited to his personality. A similar overwhelming number of voters support his right-wing agenda - despite its toxicity. This means the eventual nominee cannot sway from the former president's unpopular policies.

We asked these voters about what type of candidate they would like to support in the general election. When asked, would you be more likely to support a candidate who continued to embrace Trump's agenda or a candidate who appealed to the rapidly diversifying commonwealth - by a whopping 75% to 16%, Republican voters want their nominee to stay loyal to Trump and his policies in a general election. This closes the door to any post-primary pivot the GOP nominee could make by endangering their base support.

The 'Big Lie' Is a Motivating Factor

For base Republican voters, the 'Big Lie' achieved Trump's end goal of casting doubt on the election results. Their passionate belief in his false and dangerous conspiracy theories is the number one reason Massachusetts Republicans give as their reason to vote.

The level of resentment seeps into their perspective on the violent events at the Capitol on January 6th. Among Republicans in Massachusetts, fully 68% say Biden was not legitimately elected. Nearly 3 in 4 (72%) of Massachusetts Republicans describe the deadly events on January 6th as a false flag operation by Antifa, compared to just 13% who said it was a violent insurrection encouraged by Trump.

Conclusion

As he decides whether to seek a third term, Governor Baker is in danger of losing his own party's nomination. Republicans in Massachusetts are loyal to Trump, passionately believe the 'Big Lie,' and will force any gubernatorial candidate to take positions in a primary that make them unelectable statewide.

Baker's path to victory has never had to go through the Republican base, a group that sees him as out of touch and rates him unfavorably. These poll results show Geoff Diehl is the likely GOP nominee in 2022, regardless of whether Charlie Baker tries to run for a third term.

If Charlie Baker decided to run for a third term, he would be running from behind, as the fringe candidate. In order to start winning back support from Geoff Diehl's supporters, he would have to start bending backward and embracing Donald Trump's agenda. However, we know that any appeasement of the MAGA agenda makes Charlie Baker, or any other candidate, unelectable in the General Election - as we saw in 2018 when Geoff Diehl lost by 24 points in the General Election.
